**Education is Ceremony Scholarship**: In the same way that one can go through a traditional ceremony for purification, enlightenment, and healing, we see higher education as a modern-day ceremony offering the same rewards. Traditional ceremonies require and help grow one's discipline, patience, and gratitude; these same attributes are required and increased through the ceremony of education.

**Scholarship Award:** NHI will award \$2,000 for the 2025-2026 academic year. The award will be given in two payments; one \$1,000 payment per semester.

## **Qualifications:**

- Undergraduate sophomore, junior, or senior, Graduate or Professional student (post graduate, medical school)
- Pursuing a degree in higher education in a health related field in the 2025-2026 academic year
- Must be a full time student
- Must have more than \$1,000 in unmet need for tuition for the 25/26 academic year
